Authorizing the use of Emancipation Hall in the Capitol Visitor Center for a ceremony as part of the commemoration of the days of remembrance of victims of the Holocaust.

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF EMANCIPATION HALL FOR A CERE-**  
4 **MONY AS PART OF THE COMMEMORATION OF**  
5 **THE DAYS OF REMEMBRANCE OF VICTIMS OF**  
6 **THE HOLOCAUST.**

7        (a) **AUTHORIZATION.**—Emancipation Hall in the  
8 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on April

1 23, 2025, for a ceremony as part of the commemoration  
2 of the days of remembrance of victims of the Holocaust.

3 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the  
4 ceremony described in subsection (a) shall be carried out  
5 in accordance with such conditions as the Architect of the  
6 Capitol may prescribe.
