CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for the lying in honor of the remains of the late Charles James Kirk, a lifelong advocate for freedom of speech, civil political discourse, and the political engagement of youth.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That the remains of the late Charles James
3 Kirk, a lifelong advocate for freedom of speech, civil polit-
4 ical discourse, and the political engagement of youth, shall
5 be permitted to lie in honor in the rotunda of the Capitol
6 on a date and for a period of time to be determined by

1 the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the
2 President pro tempore of the Senate, and the Architect
3 of the Capitol, under the direction of the Speaker of the
4 House of Representatives and the President pro tempore
5 of the Senate, shall take all necessary steps for the accom-
6 plishment of that purpose.
