5 (a) **AUTHORIZATION.**—Emancipation Hall in the
6 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on April
7 14, 2026, for a ceremony as part of the commemoration
8 of the days of remembrance of victims of the Holocaust.

9 (b) **PREPARATIONS.**—Physical preparations for the
10 ceremony described in subsection (a) shall be carried out
11 in accordance with such conditions as the Architect of the
12 Capitol may prescribe.
