Mr. BARRETT submitted the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to provide that Congress and the States shall have certain authority to regulate and limit contributions and spending in campaigns for elections for public office, elections for public office, and ballot initiatives and referendums.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*
3 *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-*
4 *lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-*
5 *stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all*
6 *intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when*

1 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
2 States within seven years after the date of its submission
3 for ratification:

4 “ARTICLE —

5 “SECTION 1. We the People have compelling sov-
6 ereign interests in the freedom of speech, representative
7 self-government, federalism, the integrity of the electoral
8 process, and the political equality of natural persons.

9 “SECTION 2. Nothing in this Constitution shall be
10 construed to forbid Congress or the States, within their
11 respective jurisdictions, from reasonably regulating and
12 limiting contributions to and spending in campaigns for
13 elections for public office, elections for public office, and
14 State or local ballot initiatives or referendums, including
15 by distinguishing between natural persons and artificial
16 entities and prohibiting artificial entities from raising and
17 spending money in such campaigns, elections, and State
18 or local ballot initiatives or referendums.

19 “SECTION 3. Congress and the States shall have the
20 power to implement and enforce this article by appropriate
21 legislation.”.
