JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to Israel of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to Israel
4 is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 24–104,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.

1 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
2 Record on February 10, 2025: three thousand
3 (3,000) AGM–114 Hellfire Air-to-Ground Missiles,
4 to include one or any combination of the R3, F, F/
5 A, K1, K1A, K2, K3, K3A, KA, N, N3, and/or R
6 variants. The following non-MDE items will also be
7 included: support and test equipment; integration
8 and test support; spare and repair parts; software
9 delivery and support; publications and technical doc-
10 umentation; personnel training and training equip-
11 ment; U.S. Government and contractor engineering;
12 technical and logistics support services; storage; and
13 other related elements of logistics and program sup-
14 port.
