JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to Israel of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to Israel
4 is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 25–34,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.

1 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
2 Record on March 3, 2025: thirty-five thousand five
3 hundred twenty-nine (35,529) MK 84 or BLU-117
4 General Purpose (GP) bomb bodies, or a combina-
5 tion of both; and four thousand (4,000) I-2000 Pen-
6 etrator warheads.

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
