# JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of the United Arab Emirates of certain defense articles and services.

1        *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2        *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the following proposed foreign military sale to the  
4        Government of United Arab Emirates is prohibited:  
5                (1) The sale of the following defense articles  
6                and services described in Transmittal No. 25–25,  
7                submitted to Congress on May 13, 2025, pursuant  
8                to section 36(b)(1) of the Arms Export Control Act  
9                (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)(1)): F–16 aircraft components,

- 1 spares, and accessories; and other related elements
- 2 of logistics and program support.
