1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Words Matter for the
5 District of Columbia Courts Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES TO INDIVIDUALS WITH INTELLEC-**
7 **TUAL DISABILITIES.**

8 (a) JURISDICTION OF UNITED STATES DISTRICT
9 COURT.—Section 11–501(2)(D), District of Columbia Of-
10 ficial Code, is amended by striking “substantially retarded

1 persons” and inserting “persons with moderate intellec-
2 tual disabilities”.

3 (b) JURISDICTION OF SUPERIOR COURT.—Section
4 11–921(a)(4)(D), District of Columbia Official Code, is
5 amended by striking “substantially retarded persons” and
6 inserting “persons with moderate intellectual disabilities”.

7 (c) JURISDICTION OF FAMILY COURT.—Section 11–
8 1101(a)(15), District of Columbia Official Code, is amend-
9 ed by striking “the at least moderately mentally retarded”
10 and inserting “persons with moderate intellectual disabil-
11 ities”.
