A BILL

To require the Secretary of Homeland Security to promptly comply with State requests for information regarding the citizenship status of an individual.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Voter Eligibility
5 Verification Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROMPT RELEASE OF INFORMATION.**

7 Section 642(c) of the Illegal Immigration Reform and
8 Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C. 1373(c))

1 is amended by inserting after “by providing the requested
2 verification or status information” the following: “, includ-
3 ing by providing immigration status of an individual on
4 a list of potential voters, when requested to do so by the
5 Attorney General of a State or the Secretary of State of
6 a State within 15 days of receiving such a request”.

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
