A BILL

To repeal section 138 of the Clean Air Act, relating to environmental and climate justice block grants.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ending Green Give-
5 ways Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL AND RESCISSION RELATING TO ENVIRON-**
7 **MENTAL AND CLIMATE JUSTICE BLOCK**
8 **GRANTS.**

9 (a) REPEAL.—Section 138 of the Clean Air Act (42
10 U.S.C. 7438) is repealed.

1 (b) RESCISSION.—The unobligated balance of any
2 amounts made available under section 138 of the Clean
3 Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7438) (as in effect on the day before
4 the date of enactment of this Act) is rescinded.

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
