A BILL

To prohibit certain business concerns from receiving assistance from the Small Business Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preventing SBA As-
5 sistance from Going to China Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON SMALL BUSINESS CONCERN AF-**
2 **FILIATION WITH THE PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF**
3 **CHINA.**

4 Section 3(a) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
5 632(a)) is amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(10) PROHIBITION ON AFFILIATION WITH THE
7 PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.—For purposes of
8 this Act, a concern may not be considered a small
9 business concern if such concern is—

10 “(A) located and incorporated in the Peo-
11 ple’s Republic of China; or

12 “(B) has more than 25 percent of the vot-
13 ing stock of the concern owned by affiliates that
14 are citizens of or organized under the laws of
15 the People’s Republic of China.”.
