A BILL

To amend the Energy Conservation and Production Act to reauthorize the Weatherization Assistance Program, direct the Secretary of Energy to establish a weatherization readiness program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Weatherization En-*
 5 *hancement and Readiness Act of 2025”.*

6 **SEC. 2. WEATHERIZATION.**

7 (a) *AVERAGE COST PER DWELLING UNIT.*—Section
 8 415(c)(1) of the Energy Conservation and Production Act
 9 (42 U.S.C. 6865(c)(1)) is amended by striking “\$6,500”
 10 and inserting “\$12,000”.

11 (b) *REAUTHORIZATION OF WEATHERIZATION ASSIST-*
 12 *ANCE PROGRAM.*—Section 422 of the Energy Conservation
 13 and Production Act (42 U.S.C. 6872) is amended by strik-
 14 ing paragraphs (1) and (2) and inserting the following:

15 “(1) \$300,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2026
 16 through 2028;

17 “(2) \$325,000,000 for fiscal year 2029; and

18 “(3) \$350,000,000 for fiscal year 2030.”.

19 **SEC. 3. READINESS REPORT.**

20 Section 414D(i) of the Energy Conservation and Pro-
 21 duction Act (42 U.S.C. 6864d(i)) is amended—

22 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “; and” and
 23 inserting a semicolon;

24 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “achieved.”
 25 and inserting “achieved; and”; and

- 1 *(3) by adding at the end the following:*
- 2 *“(3) the impacts of enhancement and innovation*
- 3 *readiness efforts on eligibility for the weatherization*
- 4 *program conducted under this part.”.*

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
