To require the provision of information and counseling regarding Federal food assistance programs as part of the Transition Assistance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Veteran Should
5 Go Hungry Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROVISION OF FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAM IN-**
2 **FORMATION AS PART OF TRANSITION ASSIST-**
3 **ANCE PROGRAM.**

4 Section 1142(b) of title 10, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new para-
6 graph:

7 “(20) Information and counseling developed
8 and provided in consultation with the Secretary of
9 Agriculture, regarding Federal food and nutrition
10 assistance programs, including the supplemental nu-
11 trition assistance program established under the
12 Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2011 et
13 seq.) and the special supplemental nutrition program
14 for women, infants, and children established by sec-
15 tion 17 of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42
16 U.S.C. 1786).”.

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
