A BILL

To terminate the Shelter and Services Program of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Alien Removal Not
5 Resort Stays Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION.**

7 Beginning on the date of enactment of this Act, no
8 Federal funds are authorized to be appropriated or other-

1 wise made available to the Shelter and Services Program
2 of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, as in ef-
3 fect on the day before such date of enactment, or to any
4 successor or similar program.

5 **SEC. 3. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

6 The unobligated balances of all amounts appropriated
7 or otherwise made available to the Shelter and Services
8 Program of the Federal Emergency Management Agency
9 as of the day before the date of enactment of this Act
10 shall be transferred to and merged with amounts other-
11 wise made available to U.S. Immigration and Customs En-
12 forcement under the “U.S. Immigration and Customs En-
13 forcement—operations and support” account for nec-
14 essary expenses for enforcement, detention, and removal
15 operations.
