A BILL

To amend section 3001 of title 39, United States Code, to require solicitations sent in the mail to be clearly identified as solicitations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NOTICE OF SOLICITATION MAIL.**

4 Section 3001 of title 39, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 section:

7 “(p)(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), matter
8 otherwise legally acceptable in the mails which constitutes
9 a solicitation for the order by the addressee of goods or
10 services, or both, is nonmailable matter, shall not be car-

1 ried or delivered by mail, and shall be disposed of as the
2 Postal Service directs, unless such matter bears on its
3 face, in conspicuous and legible type in contrast by typog-
4 raphy, layout, or color with other printing on its face, in
5 accordance with regulations which the Postal Service shall
6 prescribe—

7 “(A) the following notice: ‘This is a sollicita-
8 tion’; or

9 “(B) in lieu thereof, a notice to the same effect
10 in words which the Postal Service may prescribe.

11 “(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply with respect to
12 matter described in subsection (d).”.

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
