Mr. NEGUSE (for himself, Mr. SIMPSON, and Mr. FULCHER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To authorize additional district judgeships for the districts of Colorado and Idaho.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rocky Mountain
5 Judgeship Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL DISTRICT JUDGESHIPS FOR THE DIS-**
7 **TRICTS OF COLORADO AND IDAHO.**

8 (a) COLORADO.—The President shall appoint, by and
9 with the advice and consent of the Senate, 2 additional
10 district judges for the district of Colorado.

1 (b) IDAHO.—The President shall appoint, by and
 2 with the advice and consent of the Senate, 1 additional
 3 district judges for the district of Idaho.

4 (c) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—
 5 The table in section 133(a) of title 28, United States
 6 Code, is amended—

7 (1) by striking the item relating to Colorado
 8 and inserting the following:

“Colorado 9”; and

9 (2) by striking the item relating to Idaho and
 10 inserting the following:

“Idaho 3”.

11 **SEC. 3. COLORADO.**

12 Section 85 of title 28, United States Code, is amend-
 13 ed by striking “and Sterling” and inserting “Sterling, and
 14 Fort Collins”.

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
