A BILL

To amend the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act
to provide for a lifetime National Recreational Pass for
law enforcement officers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Law Enforcement Offi-
5 cer Recreation Pass Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL RECREATIONAL PASSES FOR LAW EN-**
2 **FORCEMENT OFFICERS.**

3 Section 805(b) of the Federal Lands Recreation En-
4 hancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6804(b)) is amended by insert-
5 ing after paragraph (2) the following:

6 “(3) LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER DIS-
7 COUNT.—The Secretary shall make the National
8 Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass avail-
9 able, without charge and for the lifetime of the
10 passholder, to any law enforcement officer. For the
11 purposes of this paragraph, the term ‘law enforce-
12 ment officer’ means any officer, agent, or employee
13 of the Federal Government, a State, a unit of local
14 government, or an Indian Tribe, authorized by law
15 or by a government agency to engage in or supervise
16 the prevention, detection, or investigation of any vio-
17 lation of criminal law, or authorized by law to super-
18 vise sentenced criminal offenders.”.

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
