To amend title 38, United States Code, to include adaptive prostheses and terminal devices for sports and other recreational activities in the medical services furnished to eligible veterans by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans Supporting
5 Prosthetics Opportunities and Recreational Therapy Act”
6 or the “Veterans SPORT Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF ADAPTIVE PROSTHESES AND TER-**
2 **MINAL DEVICES FOR SPORTS AND OTHER**
3 **RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES IN MEDICAL**
4 **SERVICES FURNISHED TO ELIGIBLE VET-**
5 **ERANS BY THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AF-**
6 **FAIRS.**

7 Section 1701 of title 38, United States Code, is
8 amended, in paragraph (6)(F)(i), by inserting “(including
9 adaptive prostheses and terminal devices for sports and
10 other recreational activities)” after “artificial limbs”.

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
