AN ACT

To amend title 38, United States Code, to modify the requirements of the Edith Nourse Rogers STEM Scholarship.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Edith Nourse Rogers
3 STEM Scholarship Opportunity Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATIONS TO EDITH NOURSE ROGERS STEM**
5 **SCHOLARSHIP.**

6 Section 3320 of title 38, United States Code, is
7 amended—

8 (1) in subsection (b)—

9 (A) by striking paragraph (2);

10 (B) by redesignating paragraphs (3) and
11 (4) as paragraphs (2) and (3), respectively; and

12 (C) in paragraph (3), as so redesignated,
13 in subparagraph (A)(ii)—

14 (i) by striking “60” and inserting
15 “45”; and

16 (ii) by striking “90” and inserting
17 “67.5”;

18 (2) in subsection (c)(1)—

19 (A) by redesignating subparagraphs (A)
20 and (B) as subparagraphs (C) and (D), respec-
21 tively; and

22 (B) by inserting before subparagraph (C),
23 as so redesignated, the following new subpara-
24 graphs:

1 “(A) Individuals who have used the most num-
2 ber of months of the educational assistance to which
3 they are entitled under this chapter.

4 “(B) Individuals who are using their entitle-
5 ment under this chapter to pursue a program of
6 post-secondary education and who have declared a
7 major in a field referred to in subsection
8 (b)(3)(A)(i).”; and

9 (3) in subsection (d), by adding at the end the
10 following new paragraph:

11 “(5) An individual who receives a benefit under this
12 section may only use such benefit after the individual has
13 used all of the educational assistance to which the indi-
14 vidual is entitled under this chapter.”.

15 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN LIMITS ON PAYMENTS OF**
16 **PENSION.**

17 Section 5503(d)(7) of title 38, United States Code,
18 is amended by striking “November 30, 2031” and insert-
19 ing “March 31, 2033”.
