A BILL

To prevent 340B covered entities from using savings derived for sex reassignment surgeries, hormonal therapies, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No 340B Savings for
5 Transgender Care Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF 340B SAVINGS FOR SERV-**
 2 **ICES DESCRIBED FOR TRANSGENDER INDI-**
 3 **VIDUALS.**

4 (a) PROHIBITION ON USE OF 340B SAVINGS FOR
 5 SERVICES DESCRIBED.—Section 340B(a)(4) of the Public
 6 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 256b(a)(5)) is amended by
 7 adding at the end the following:

8 “(E) PROHIBITION ON USE OF 340B SAV-
 9 INGS FOR SERVICES DESCRIBED.—A covered
 10 entity participating in the program under this
 11 section may not use any funds derived from the
 12 difference between the 340B ceiling price and
 13 the actual acquisition cost of covered outpatient
 14 drugs to pay for services described.

15 “(i) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of
 16 this subsection—

17 “(I) COVERED ENTITY.—The
 18 term ‘covered entities’ has the mean-
 19 ing given such term in section
 20 340B(a)(4).

21 “(II) SERVICES DESCRIBED.—
 22 The term ‘services described’ means—

23 “(aa) sex reassignment sur-
 24 geries furnished for the purpose
 25 of the gender alteration of a
 26 transgender individual; and

1 “(bb) hormone treatments
2 furnished for the purpose of the
3 gender alteration of a
4 transgender individual.”.

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
