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## A BILL

To require the Attorney General to submit to the Congress a report that includes the demographic data of persons determined to be ineligible to purchase a firearm based on a background check performed by the National Instant Criminal Background Check System.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “NICS Data Reporting  
5       Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NICS REPORT.**

2 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment  
3 of this Act, and annually thereafter, the Attorney General  
4 shall submit to the Committee on the Judiciary of the Sen-  
5 ate and the Committee on the Judiciary of the House of  
6 Representatives a report that includes, with respect to the  
7 preceding year, the demographic data of persons who were  
8 determined to be ineligible to purchase a firearm based  
9 on a background check performed by the National Instant  
10 Criminal Background Check System, including race, eth-  
11 nicity, national origin, sex, gender, age, disability, average  
12 annual income, and English language proficiency, if avail-  
13 able.

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
