Mr. MILLS (for himself and Mr. HARRIS of Maryland) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to clarify birthright citizenship, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prohibiting Automatic
5 Rights to Enter National Territory Act of 2025” or as
6 the “PARENT Act of 2025”.

7 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF BIRTHRIGHT CITIZENSHIP.**

8 Section 101 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
9 (8 U.S.C. 1101) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
10 lowing:

1 “(j) For purposes of section 301(a), the term ‘subject
2 to the jurisdiction thereof’ means, with respect to a person
3 born in the United States, that the person was born to
4 a parent who is, at the time of the person’s birth, a citizen
5 of the United States or an alien who is a lawful permanent
6 resident of the United States.”.

7 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

8 This Act, and the amendments made by this Act,
9 shall apply to persons born after the date of enactment
10 of this Act.

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
