Ms. MALLIOTAKIS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To allow certain veterans to use high occupancy vehicle lanes, including toll lanes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “HOV Lanes for Heroes
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. HOV FACILITIES.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 166(b) of title 23, United
8 States Code, is amended by inserting at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

10 “(7) DISABLED VETERANS.—

1 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The public authority
2 may allow a disabled veteran to use the HOV
3 facility if such veteran has a license plate that
4 clearly identifies the vehicle, a registered trans-
5 ponder, or other method of identification the
6 public authority considers necessary for quali-
7 fication.

8 “(B) DEFINITION OF DISABLED VET-
9 ERAN.—For purposes of this paragraph, the
10 term ‘disabled veteran’ means a veteran (as
11 such term is defined in section 101 of title 38)
12 who the Secretary of Veterans Affairs has de-
13 termined has a service-connected (as such term
14 is defined in such section) disability rated at or
15 above a percentage determined to be qualifying
16 by the public authority.

17 “(C) OCCUPANCY EXCEPTION.—Notwith-
18 standing the occupancy requirement of sub-
19 section (a)(2), 1 occupant described in subpara-
20 graph (B) of this paragraph may be permitted
21 to use a HOV facility.

22 “(D) NO CHARGE FOR TOLLS.—Under this
23 paragraph, a public authority may charge no
24 toll.”.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 166 of
2 such title is further amended—

3 (1) in subsection (b)(1) by striking “through
4 (5)” and inserting “through (7)”; and

5 (2) in subsection (d)(1) by striking “paragraph
6 (4) or (5)” and inserting “paragraph (4), (5), (6),
7 or (7)”.

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
