Mr. COHEN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit the President from personally profiting from Secret Service protection.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Making Any Reim-
5 bursement Against the Law for Guarding Overnight Act”
6 or the “MARALAGO Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON USE OF FUNDS BY UNITED STATES**

8 **SECRET SERVICE.**

9 (a) LIMITATION.—No Federal funds may be used by
10 the Director of the United States Secret Service to pur-

1 chase, rent, lease, or otherwise procure from a President
2 or any entity owned or controlled by a President, or to
3 reimburse a President or any entity owned or controlled
4 by a President for, lodging, meals, office space, or any
5 other expense incurred by the United States Secret Service
6 during the course of protecting a President at the Presi-
7 dent's residence.

8 (b) GIFTING PERMITTED.—Notwithstanding any
9 other provision of law, a President or an entity owned or
10 controlled by a President, may gift to the United States
11 Secret Service lodging, meals, office space, or any other
12 expense incurred by the United States Secret Service dur-
13 ing the course of protecting a President at the President
14 or former President's residence.

15 (c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “Presi-
16 dent” includes a former President.

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
