Mr. DUNN of Florida introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To authorize the waiver of costs of activities relating to evacuation of United States citizens when their lives are endangered by war or acts of terrorism.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF COSTS OF ACTIVITIES RELATING**
4 **TO EVACUATION OF UNITED STATES CITI-**
5 **ZENS WHEN THEIR LIVES ARE ENDANGERED**
6 **BY WAR OR ACTS OF TERRORISM.**

7 Section 4 of the State Department Basic Authorities
8 Act of 1956 (22 U.S.C. 2671) is amended by adding at
9 the end the following:

1 “(e) With regard to the repatriations loan program,
2 the Secretary of State is authorized to waive the costs of
3 activities relating to evacuation of United States citizens
4 when their lives are endangered by war or acts of ter-
5 rorism.”.

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
