Mr. KENNEDY of New York introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Agriculture

A BILL

To temporarily expand the supplemental nutrition assistance program income eligibility of households that include certain veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Setting the Table for
5 Transition Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TEMPORARY EXPANDED SNAP INCOME ELIGIBILITY**
7 **OF HOUSEHOLDS THAT INCLUDE CERTAIN**
8 **VETERANS.**

9 For the purpose of determining income under the
10 Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.)

1 during the 100-day period that begins on the date a vet-
2 eran receives a Report of Separation (DD form 214) of
3 a household that includes a member who is a veteran, only
4 the income of such veteran shall be considered.

5 **SEC. 3. DEFINITION.**

6 For purposes of this Act, the term “veteran” means
7 an individual who served in the active military, naval, or
8 air service, and who was discharged or released therefrom
9 under conditions other than dishonorable.

10 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

11 This Act shall take effect 90 days after the date of
12 the enactment of this Act.

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
