A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to prohibit the issuance of nationwide injunctions from single-judge divisions of U.S. District Courts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End Judge Shopping
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ORDERS PURPORTING TO RESTRAIN ENFORCE-**
7 **MENT AGAINST NON-PARTIES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 87 of title 28, United
9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
10 lowing:

1 **“§ 1414. Civil actions seeking nationwide injunctions**

2 “A civil action which seeks an order enforceable in
3 each district and division of the United States shall be
4 brought only in a division of a judicial district which has
5 two or more active judges assigned.”.

6 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
7 for such chapter is amended by adding at the end the fol-
8 lowing:

“1414. Civil actions seeking nationwide injunctions.”.
