Mr. BARR introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To redesignate Camp Nelson National Monument, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Camp Nelson National
5 Monument Boundary Expansion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF LAND ACQUISITION.**

7 The Secretary of the Interior may acquire the ap-
8 proximately 132 acres of land and interests in land gen-
9 erally depicted as “Proposed Monument Boundary Expan-
10 sion” on the map titled “Camp Nelson National Monu-
11 ment Proposed Boundary Expansion Nicholasville, Ken-

1 tucky”, numbered 532/174,965 and dated April 29, 2025,
2 for inclusion in the Camp Nelson National Monument.

3 **SEC. 3. CAMP NELSON NATIONAL MONUMENT.**

4 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 2303 of the John D. Din-
5 gell, Jr. Conservation, Management, and Recreation Act
6 (Public Law 116–9) is amended—

7 (1) in the heading, by striking “**HERITAGE**”;

8 (2) in subsection (a)(2), by striking “Camp
9 Nelson Heritage National Monument” and inserting
10 “Camp Nelson National Monument”; and

11 (3) in subsection (b)(1), by striking “Camp
12 Nelson Heritage National Monument” and inserting
13 “Camp Nelson National Monument”.

14 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
15 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
16 States to Camp Nelson Heritage National Monument shall
17 be deemed to be a reference to Camp Nelson National
18 Monument.

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
