Mr. GOLDMAN of New York (for himself and Mr. FIELDS) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Workforce

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## A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to include service as a volunteer firefighter or volunteer emergency medical technician as a public service job for purposes of eligibility for the Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Helping Emergency  
5 Responders Overcome Student Debt Act” or the “HE-  
6 ROES Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LOAN FORGIVENESS FOR VOLUNTEER FIRST RE-**  
2 **SPONDERS.**

3 Section 455(m)(3) of the Higher Education Act of  
4 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1087e(m)(3)) is amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (B)—

6 (A) in clause (i), by striking “or” after the  
7 semicolon;

8 (B) in clause (ii), by striking the period at  
9 the end and inserting “; or”; and

10 (C) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(iii) volunteer work as a qualified  
12 volunteer firefighter or qualified volunteer  
13 emergency medical technician in accord-  
14 ance with subparagraph (C).”; and

15 (2) by adding at the end the following:

16 “(C) QUALIFIED VOLUNTEER FIRE-  
17 FIGHTER; QUALIFIED EMERGENCY MEDICAL  
18 TECHNICIAN.—

19 “(i) The term ‘qualified volunteer fire-  
20 fighter’ means an individual who—

21 “(I) provides firefighting services,  
22 fire prevention services, emergency  
23 medical services, or other related  
24 emergency response services on behalf  
25 of a legally recognized fire department  
26 or public safety organization; and

1           “(II) is not otherwise directly  
2           employed on a full-time basis by the  
3           same fire department or public safety  
4           organization for which they provide  
5           such services.

6           “(ii) The term ‘qualified volunteer  
7           emergency medical technician’ means an  
8           individual who—

9                   “(I) is trained and certified, li-  
10                  censed, or otherwise authorized under  
11                  applicable state or local laws to pro-  
12                  vide emergency medical care, pre-hos-  
13                  pital care, or ambulance services in  
14                  response to medical emergencies;

15                   “(II) performs such care or serv-  
16                  ices on behalf of an ambulance serv-  
17                  ice, fire department, healthcare facil-  
18                  ity, or public safety organization; and

19                   “(III) is not otherwise directly  
20                  employed on a full-time basis by the  
21                  same ambulance service, fire depart-  
22                  ment, healthcare facility, or public  
23                  safety organization for which they  
24                  provide such care or services.

25                  “(iii) The Secretary shall—

1           “(I) determine the minimum vol-  
2           unteer time required for a qualified  
3           volunteer firefighter or a qualified vol-  
4           unteer emergency medical technician  
5           to be treated as an individual em-  
6           ployed in a full-time job for purposes  
7           of this subsection; and

8           “(II) ensure that such minimum  
9           volunteer time is not less than the  
10          amount of volunteer time that is re-  
11          quired for the qualified volunteer fire-  
12          fighter or a qualified volunteer emer-  
13          gency medical technician to be consid-  
14          ered an active member of the relevant  
15          ambulance service, fire department,  
16          healthcare facility, or public safety or-  
17          ganization.

18          “(D) PUBLIC SAFETY ORGANIZATION.—  
19          The term ‘public safety organization’ means  
20          any State, local, or tribal governmental agency  
21          or nonprofit organization that has the principal  
22          purpose of protecting the safety of life, health,  
23          or property.”.

1 **SEC. 3. REGULATIONS.**

2       The Secretary of Education shall promulgate, after  
3 consultation with public safety organizations (which shall  
4 include firefighter and emergency responder organiza-  
5 tions), regulations to carry out the amendments made by  
6 section 2, including regulations relating to—

7           (1) the minimum volunteer time required for a  
8       qualified volunteer firefighter and qualified volunteer  
9       emergency medical technician to be treated as an in-  
10      dividual employed in a full-time job for purposes of  
11      section 455(m) of the Higher Education Act of 1965  
12      (20 U.S.C. 1087e(m)); and

13           (2) the process of tracking and verifying that  
14      volunteer time.

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
