A BILL

To amend section 287 of the Immigration and Nationality Act with respect to certain uniform requirements for United States immigration officers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS FOR UNITED**
4 **STATES IMMIGRATION OFFICERS.**

5 Section 287 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
6 (8 U.S.C. 1357) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing:

8 “(h)(1) The Secretary of Homeland Security shall re-
9 quire covered immigration officers to identify themselves

1 as such officers by displaying bold and visible identifica-
2 tion during a time of action.

3 “(2) For the purposes of this subsection—

4 “(A) the term ‘bold and visible identifica-
5 tion’ means—

6 “(i) identification of the agency that
7 the covered immigration officer represents
8 no smaller than 12 inches by 6 inches on
9 the front or back of the uniform of such
10 officer; and

11 “(ii) the identification described under
12 clause (i) is not covered by external pieces
13 of a uniform, including external armor or
14 accessories;

15 “(B) the term ‘covered immigration officer’
16 means—

17 “(i) personnel of the U.S. Customs
18 and Border Protection;

19 “(ii) personnel of the U.S. Immigra-
20 tion and Customs Enforcement; and

21 “(iii) any other official deputized by
22 the Secretary of Homeland Security to en-
23 gage in immigration enforcement actions.

1 “(C) the term ‘time of action’ includes any
2 immigration enforcement action such as a pa-
3 trol, raid, pickup, or serving a warrant.”.

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
