A BILL

To modify the boundary of the Mammoth Cave National Park in the State of Kentucky, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mammoth Cave Na-
5 tional Park Boundary Adjustment Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. MAMMOTH CAVE NATIONAL PARK BOUNDARY**
7 **MODIFICATION.**

8 Section 11 of the Act of June 5, 1942 (56 Stat. 319,
9 chapter 341; 16 U.S.C. 404c–11), is amended—

1 (1) in the second paragraph, by inserting “(ad-
2 justed for inflation in accordance with the Consumer
3 Price Index published by the Bureau of Labor Sta-
4 tistics of the Department of Labor)” after
5 “\$350,000”; and

6 (2) by inserting after the second paragraph the
7 following:

8 “‘The Secretary of the Interior may acquire the ap-
9 proximately 551.14 acres of land and any interests in land
10 generally depicted as ‘Proposed Addition’ on the map enti-
11 tled ‘Mammoth Cave National Park Proposed Southern
12 Boundary Expansion Edmonson and Barren Counties,
13 Kentucky’, numbered 135/177,967 and dated May 2025,
14 for inclusion in the Mammoth Cave National Park.’”.

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
