A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to assert jurisdiction over murders committed by certain inadmissible or deportable aliens.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Justice for Victims
5 of Illegal Alien Murders Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MURDERS COMMITTED BY CERTAIN INADMISSIBLE**
7 **OR DEPORTABLE ALIENS.**

8 Section 1111 of title 18, United States Code, is
9 amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(d) Within any jurisdiction of the United States
2 (whether or not in the special maritime and territorial ju-
3 risdiction of the United States), an alien who—

4 “(1) is—

5 “(A) inadmissible under paragraph (6)(A),
6 (6)(C), or (7) of section 212(a) of the Immigra-
7 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)); or

8 “(B) deportable under subparagraph (B)
9 or (C)(i) of section 237(a)(1) of such Act (8
10 U.S.C. 1227(a)(1)); and

11 “(2) is guilty of—

12 “(A) murder in the first degree, shall be
13 punished by death or by imprisonment for life;
14 or

15 “(B) murder in the second degree, shall be
16 imprisoned for any term of years or for life.”.

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
