Mr. OGLES introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To require an exception to the license requirements for the exportation of certain advanced integrated circuits to Israel, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “America—Israel AI
5 Cooperation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DIRECTED RULEMAKING WITH RESPECT TO AD-**
7 **VANCED INTEGRATED CIRCUIT EXPOR-**
8 **TATION TO ISRAEL.**

9 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in final-
10 izing the interim rule titled “Framework for Artificial In-

1 telligence Diffusion” (90 Fed. Reg. 4544) the Secretary
2 of Commerce, acting through the Undersecretary of Com-
3 merce for Industry and Security, shall modify the rule
4 to—

5 (1) include Israel in the list of countries set
6 forth in the amendment made by such rule to Sup-
7 plement No. 5 to part 740 of title 15, Code of Fed-
8 eral Regulations; and

9 (2) otherwise ensure that exports to Israel of
10 the items controlled pursuant to such rule are sub-
11 ject to the same requirements and exceptions as ex-
12 ports to any of the countries otherwise included in
13 such supplement pursuant to the amendment made
14 by such rule.

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
