A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to repeal the National Firearms Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Repeal the NFA Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF NATIONAL FIREARMS ACT.**

6 Chapter 53 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986,
7 and the item relating to such chapter in the table of chap-
8 ters for subtitle E, are hereby repealed.
