A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to submit to Congress a report regarding the transfer of an aircraft from Qatar, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Suspending Transfer
5 of Property for Improper Trump Use Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DOCUMENTS REQUESTED.**

2 Not later than 30 days after the date of the enact-
3 ment of this act, the Secretary of State shall furnish to
4 the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
5 resentatives and the Committee on Foreign Relations of
6 the Senate copies of all documents, Signal chats, memo-
7 randa, charts, tables, notes from meetings, audio record-
8 ings, records (including telephone and email records), cor-
9 respondence, artificial intelligence large language model
10 conversation transcripts, and any other communications
11 within the Department of State or the National Security
12 Council, or external communication with the State of
13 Qatar, pertaining to the transfer of an aircraft to the
14 United States Government, to be subsequently transferred
15 to an entity controlled by President Donald J. Trump.

16 **SEC. 3. REPORT.**

17 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
18 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State
19 shall submit to the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
20 House of Representatives and the Committee on Foreign
21 Relations of the Senate a report detailing the negotiations
22 between the United States and Qatar pertaining to the
23 transfer of an aircraft from Qatar to the United States,
24 to be subsequently transferred to an entity controlled by
25 President Trump.

1 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re-
2 quired by subsection (a) shall include the following:

3 (1) A description of any and all communica-
4 tions pertaining to promises or commitments made
5 or proposed to be made to Qatar in exchange for the
6 transfer described in subsection (a), whether trans-
7 mitted verbally or in writing.

8 (2) A recounting of any negotiation with private
9 sector entities to receive contracts as a result of the
10 potential or completed transfer described in sub-
11 section (a).

12 (3) Information pertaining to the legal review
13 conducted by the Secretary regarding the potential
14 or completed transfer described in subsection (a).

15 **SEC. 4. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING WITH RE-**
16 **SPECT TO CERTAIN AIRCRAFT TRANSFERS.**

17 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Fed-
18 eral funds are authorized to be appropriated or otherwise
19 made available to take any action to support, facilitate,
20 or execute the transfer of an aircraft owned by a foreign
21 government or an entity controlled by a foreign govern-
22 ment to the United States Government, the President of
23 the United States, or to the Presidential Library of Presi-
24 dent Trump.

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
