Ms. DE LA CRUZ (for herself, Mr. BABIN, Mr. WEBER of Texas, Mr. SESSIONS, Mr. ELLZEY, Mr. GILL of Texas, and Mr. SELF) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To require that the flag of the United States of America
be flown at its highest peak on Inauguration Day.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Honor Inauguration
5 Day Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds the following:

8 (1) The United States of America has a long
9 and continual electoral history that serves as exam-
10 ple and inspiration for other nations.

1 (2) The United States of America has in the
2 vote the ultimate expression of the will of the people.

3 (3) The will of the people is to be celebrated.

4 (4) To commemorate and celebrate the expres-
5 sion of the will of the people, on Inauguration Day
6 the American flag should always be flown at its
7 highest peak and should not be lowered.

8 **SEC. 3. REQUIREMENT FOR UNITED STATES FLAG ON INAU-**
9 **GURATION DAY.**

10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the flag
11 of the United States of America shall be flown at its high-
12 est peak on each presidential Inauguration Day.

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
