2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BONNEVILLE SHORELINE TRAIL FEASIBILITY**
4 **STUDY.**

5 Section 5(c) of the National Trails System Act (16
6 U.S.C. 1244(c)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing:

8 “(50) BONNEVILLE SHORELINE TRAIL.—The
9 Bonneville Shoreline Trail, a system of trails and po-

1 tential trails extending approximately 280 miles
2 from the Idaho-Utah border to Nephi, Utah, fol-
3 lowing the Bonneville bench that was created by the
4 historic Lake Bonneville.”.

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
