# **A BILL**

To clarify that the installation of mechanical insulation property is an energy or water efficiency measure that may be used in Federal buildings for purposes of section 543(f) of the National Energy Conservation Policy Act, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Federal Mechanical  
5 Insulation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. INSTALLATION OF MECHANICAL INSULATION PROP-**  
7 **ERTY AS AN ENERGY OR WATER EFFICIENCY**  
8 **MEASURE IN FEDERAL BUILDINGS.**

9        (a) DEFINITION OF MECHANICAL INSULATION PROP-  
10 ERTY.—Section 543(f)(1) of the National Energy Con-  
11 servation Policy Act (42 U.S.C. 8253(f)(1)) is amended  
12 by adding at the end the following:

13                “(I) MECHANICAL INSULATION PROP-  
14 ERTY.—The term ‘mechanical insulation prop-  
15 erty’ means insulation materials, facings, and  
16 accessory products—

17                        “(i) placed in service—

18                                “(I) in connection with a me-  
19 chanical system; and

20                                “(II) in a manner that meets or  
21 exceeds the minimum requirements of  
22 the American Society of Heating, Re-  
23 frigerating and Air-Conditioning En-  
24 gineers Standard 90.1, as in effect on

1 the date of enactment of this subpara-  
2 graph; and  
3 “(ii) which result in a reduction in en-  
4 ergy loss from the mechanical system.”.

5 (b) COMPREHENSIVE ENERGY AND WATER EVALUA-  
6 TIONS.—Section 543(f)(3)(A) of the National Energy  
7 Conservation Policy Act (42 U.S.C. 8253(f)(3)(A)) is  
8 amended by inserting “, including identification of energy-  
9 and water-saving measures (including the installation of  
10 mechanical insulation property, if applicable),” after “a  
11 comprehensive energy and water evaluation”.



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
