A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to provide for electronic communication relating to educational assistance benefits under the laws administered by the Secretary, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Delivering Digitally
5 to Our Veterans Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ELECTRONIC**
2 **COMMUNICATION RELATING TO EDU-**
3 **CATIONAL ASSISTANCE BENEFITS.**

4 Section 3680 of title 38, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 section:

7 “(i)(1) The Secretary shall provide a mechanism by
8 which an eligible veteran or eligible person may electroni-
9 cally send and receive correspondence with the Depart-
10 ment of Veterans related to entitlement to and use of edu-
11 cational assistance benefits under the laws administered
12 by the Secretary. The Secretary shall ensure that an eligi-
13 ble veteran or eligible person is provided with an oppor-
14 tunity to opt into sending and receiving such correspond-
15 ence electronically rather than by mail.

16 “(2) The Secretary shall provide to eligible veterans
17 and eligible persons who are enrolled in a course or pro-
18 gram of education or training notice of the opportunity
19 to opt in to sending and receiving correspondence elec-
20 tronically pursuant to paragraph (1).”.

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
