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## A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration to apply the final rule relating to valve installation and minimum rupture detection standards to Type A gas gathering lines, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Valve Safety Fairness  
5 Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF RULE TO TYPE A GAS GATHERING**  
2 **LINES.**

3 The Administrator of the Pipeline and Hazardous  
4 Materials Safety Administration shall take such actions as  
5 are necessary to apply the final rule of the Administration,  
6 titled “Pipeline Safety: Requirement of Valve Installation  
7 and Minimum Rupture Detection Standards” and pub-  
8 lished on April 8, 2022 (87 Fed. Reg. 20940), to Type  
9 A gas gathering lines.

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
