Mr. MULLIN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to take affirmative action to ensure meaningful language access to persons who are limited English proficient.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Language Access in
5 Transit Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. NONDISCRIMINATION IN LANGUAGE ACCESS.**

7 Section 5332 of title 49, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) in subsection (c) by adding at the end the
10 following new paragraph:

1 “(3) The Secretary shall take affirmative action
2 to ensure all persons receiving financial assistance
3 under this chapter provide meaningful language ac-
4 cess to services provided with such financial assist-
5 ance to persons who are limited English proficient.”;
6 and

7 (2) in subsection (d) by striking “subsection
8 (b)” and inserting “subsections (b) and (c)(3)”.
