3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN FEDERAL GOVERN-**
4 **MENT USE OF FACIAL RECOGNITION TECH-**
5 **NOLOGY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—An agency of the Federal Govern-
7 ment may not use facial recognition technology as a means
8 of identity verification.

9 (b) FACIAL RECOGNITION TECHNOLOGY DEFINED.—
10 In this section, the term “facial recognition technology”

- 1 means a contemporary security system that automatically
- 2 identifies and verifies the identity of an individual from
- 3 a digital image or video frame.
