3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Water Quality Tech-
5 nology Availability Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFYING EFFLUENT LIMITATION GUIDELINES.**

2 Section 304(b)(1)(B) of the Federal Water Pollution
3 Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1314(b)(1)(B)) is amended by
4 striking “technology in relation to” and inserting “tech-
5 nology that is commercially available in the United States
6 in relation to”.

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
