Mr. DUNN of Florida (for himself, Mr. SOTO, and Mr. BEAN of Florida) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to authorize the Secretary of Health and Human Services to address priority substance use disorder and serious mental illness treatment needs through long-acting injectable medications, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Treatment Continuity
5 Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. PRIORITY SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER AND SERI-**
2 **OUS MENTAL ILLNESS TREATMENT NEEDS**
3 **OF REGIONAL AND NATIONAL SIGNIFICANCE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 509 of the Public Health
5 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 290bb–2) is amended—

6 (1) in the section heading, by inserting “**AND**
7 **SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS**” after “**SUBSTANCE**
8 **USE DISORDER**”;

9 (2) in subsection (a)—

10 (A) in the matter preceding paragraph (1),
11 by inserting “and serious mental illness” after
12 “substance use disorder”; and

13 (B) by striking paragraphs (1) through (3)
14 and inserting the following: “

15 “(1) access to long-acting injectable medications
16 that are approved by the Food and Drug Adminis-
17 tration for the treatment of individuals with sub-
18 stance use disorders or serious mental illness;

19 “(2) lab testing and supportive counseling for
20 substance use disorder and serious mental illness;
21 and

22 “(3) training on the use of long-acting
23 injectable medications for the purposes described in
24 paragraph (1), in combination with associated clin-
25 ical services such as counseling.”;

26 (3) in subsection (b)—

1 (A) in the subsection heading, by inserting
2 “AND SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS” after “SUB-
3 STANCE USE DISORDER”; and

4 (B) in paragraphs (1) and (2), by inserting
5 “and serious mental illness” after “substance
6 use disorder”;

7 (4) by striking subsections (d) and (e) and in-
8 serting the following:

9 “(d) ANNUAL REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later
10 than 1 year after the date of enactment of the Treatment
11 Continuity Act of 2025, and annually thereafter during
12 the term of the program under this section, the Secretary
13 shall transmit to Congress a report on the outcomes of
14 such program, including completed or substantial progress
15 toward treatment requirements based on clinician assess-
16 ment.”; and

17 (5) by redesignating subsection (f) as sub-
18 section (e).

19 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by this
20 section shall apply to grants made under section 509 of
21 the Public Health Service Act after the date of the enact-
22 ment of this Act.

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
