1 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY ADJUSTMENT TO A RATE OF THE**
2 **BASIC ALLOWANCE FOR HOUSING FOR MEM-**
3 **BERS OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES: LOWER**
4 **THRESHOLD; PERMANENT AUTHORITY.**

5 Section 403(b)(8) of title 37, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “20 per-
8 cent” and inserting “15 percent”; and

9 (2) by striking subparagraph (C).
