Mr. OLSZEWSKI (for himself and Mr. HUIZENGA) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To extend certain privileges and immunities to the Perma-
nent Observer Mission of the African Union to the
United Nations in New York.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “African Union Diplo-
5 matic Parity Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNI-**
7 **TIES TO THE AFRICAN UNION.**

8 Section 12(b) of the International Organizations Im-
9 munities Act (22 U.S.C. 288f–2(b)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “extend, to the African Union
2 Mission” and inserting “extend—
3 “(1) to the African Union Mission”;
4 (2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
5 ing “; and”; and
6 (3) by adding at the end the following:
7 “(2) to the Permanent Observer Mission of the
8 African Union to the United Nations in New York,
9 and to its members, the privileges and immunities
10 enjoyed by the permanent missions to the United
11 Nations of member states, and their members, sub-
12 ject to corresponding conditions and obligations.”.
