Ms. TENNEY (for herself and Mr. MORELLE) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Agriculture

A BILL

To require the Secretary of Agriculture to annually publish certain data with respect to grape production, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fairness in Vineyard
5 Data Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. GRAPE PRODUCTION DATA.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Agriculture, act-
8 ing through the Administrator of the National Agricul-
9 tural Statistics Service, shall—

1 (1) not later than 1 year after the date of the
2 enactment of this Act—

3 (A) conduct a survey on grape production
4 in each State, including—

5 (i) total acreage; and

6 (ii) production, utilization, and acre-
7 age by type, variety, county, and year
8 planted; and

9 (B) make publicly available on the website
10 of the National Agricultural Statistics Service
11 the results of such survey and the data from
12 such survey; and

13 (2) not later than 2 years after the date of the
14 enactment of this Act and annually for the 3 years
15 thereafter, make publicly available on the website of
16 the National Agricultural Statistics Service data
17 from the 5 States with the highest grape production
18 in the preceding year, as determined using data
19 from the survey required under paragraph (1)(A).

20 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

21 (1) SURVEY.—There is authorized to be appro-
22 priated to carry out subparagraphs (A) and (B) of
23 subsection (a)(1) \$2,500,000 for fiscal year 2026.

24 (2) PUBLICATION OF DATA.—There is author-
25 ized to be appropriated to carry out subsection

- 1 (a)(2) \$1,500,000 for each of fiscal years 2027
2 through 2030.
