A BILL

To repeal sanctions with respect to the Syrian Arab Republic, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Syria Sanctions Relief
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF MEASURES WITH RESPECT TO THE SYR-**
2 **IAN ARAB REPUBLIC.**

3 (a) REPEAL OF THE SYRIA HUMAN RIGHTS AC-
4 COUNTABILITY ACT OF 2012.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—Title VII of the Iran Threat
6 Reduction and Syria Human Rights Act of 2012 (22
7 U.S.C. 8791 et seq.) is repealed.

8 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The table of
9 contents for such Act is amended by striking the
10 items relating to title VII.

11 (b) REPEAL OF THE CAESAR SYRIA CIVILIAN PRO-
12 TECTION ACT OF 2019.—Title LXXIV of the National
13 Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 (Public
14 Law 116–92) is repealed.

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
