A BILL

To amend Public Law 86–272 to expand the prohibition of State taxation relating to certain solicitation of orders.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Interstate Commerce
5 Simplification Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

7 Section 101(d) of Public Law 86–272 (73 Stat. 555)
8 is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “and” at the
10 end,

1 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking the period at
2 the end and inserting “; and”, and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(3) the term ‘solicitation of orders’ means any
5 business activity that facilitates the solicitation of
6 orders even if that activity may also serve some
7 independently valuable business function apart from
8 solicitation.”.

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
