A BILL

To amend section 287 of the Immigration and Nationality Act with respect to identification requirements for officers and agents of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “ICE Badge Visibility
5 Act of 2025”.

1 **SECTION 2. IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR UNITED**
2 **STATES IMMIGRATION OFFICERS.**

3 Section 287 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
4 (8 U.S.C. 1357) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing:

6 “(i) The Secretary of Homeland Security shall re-
7 quire an officer or agent of the U.S. Immigration and Cus-
8 toms Enforcement to display a badge number dem-
9 onstrating their affiliation with such agency on their per-
10 son while questioning, arresting, or detaining any indi-
11 vidual.”.

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
